Schedule Ease does not require any special printer configuration. As a result, its reports will print standard quality output on almost any printer with no special setup required.

The simplest method to print is to access the extensive report

capabilities provided by the F3 print menus. However, following is a detailed listing of printing "speed" keys you may utilize.

POP UP MENUS

As you have noticed, throughout the documentation, reference has been made to the Alt key combinations we refer to as "speed" keys as detailed for the report printing modules.

These "speed" key combinations once learned provide the quickest access to the various features of Schedule Ease. However, a complete and comprehensive pop up menu structure has been provided to offer the greatest possible ease of use in utilizing Schedule Ease as a tool in your business.

Simply press the function keys which are always present at the bottom of the screen you are viewing and you can print, navigate or structure Schedule Ease in an almost endless variety of configurations. Experiment, you will be more than pleased with the results.

By pressing the (/) slash bar, a menu will appear at the top of the screen you are viewing, giving you extensive formatting, copying and

editing capabilities while using Schedule Ease.

MOUSE SUPPORT

Schedule Ease offers total mouse support for range identification, cursor movement and option selection in the Global Commands menus. Also, you will find the mouse speed bar present to the right of all screens to assist you in navigation of the program.

In addition, help is always available by placing the mouse cursor on the "?" of the speed bar and clicking. This will return you to the documentation of the program. This is one of four methods of accessing documentation help, along with pressing the F1 function key, choosing the opening screen option from the Navigation menu, or using the speed key combination, Alt O.
