Enclosed with this document is a floppy containing my entry to the "Take Command of Symphony" contest.

The macro allows one to print address labels from a database. The user is given the choice to print the entire database, in standard sheet format, or to print labels, either one label for each entry in the database, or a bunch of labels from one entry. It will also move up the 'city, state and zip code' line if the 'Address2' field is blank. This macro is in fact portable, and can be attached to any database, without inordinate amounts of work, as long as the label formulas are set correctly, and the print settings sheets are set up (it is no less portable than a "C" program). The macro is currently set for 1.5" labels, in order to set it for 1" labels, go into the "macro" window and reset the ranges "allabels" and "onelabel" from nine lines long to six.
