Winpopup

The Winpopup utility enables you to receive messages from other network users. Each time you receive a message, the Winpopup utility pops up and beeps.

After you read a message:

Choose **Discard** to dismiss the message.

When you discard a message, it is stored in the MESSAGES.LOG file in the LANMAN.DOS\ LOGS directory. The Winpopup utility can hold up to five messages at a time. If you receive more than five messages at one time, the oldest message is automatically discarded and stored in the MESSAGES.LOG file.

If you don't want to receive messages, you can close the Winpopup utility. If you close Winpopup, your messages are still stored in the MESSAGES.LOG file. The Winpopup utility is started again each time you start Windows.

To close the Winpopup utility:

- 1. Select the Winpopup utility.
- 2. Select Close.
