#### 1.3 Info about InfoX

 $\star$  InfoX is CLI/Shell utility which shows informations about  ${\tt XPK}$ 

sub-libraries. Never run it from Workbench!

- \* InfoX was written in assembler, that's why it is fast and small.
- \* InfoX can show info about given packer(s) or all available packers. You can also get info about packer's modes.
- \* InfoX can be interrupted by Ctrl-C.

### 1.4 Requirements

InfoX needs the following things:

- \* Kickstart v2.04 (37.175) or newer
- \* xpkmaster.library v2 or newer (in LIBS: directory)
- $\star$  some xpk sublibs (in LIBS:Compressors directory)

InfoX is CLI/Shell utility. Never run it from Workbench!

InfoX <packer(s)> [MODES]

Template: PACKER/M, MODES/S

Where:

PACKER - four-letter name of the packer, for example: InfoX RLEN

shows info about xpkRLEN.library

MODES - show also all modes available for packer(s), for example: InfoX NUKE MODES

shows info about xpkNUKE.library with all its modes
