1.2 What is ROT13?

ROT13 is a little program that converts ASCII-Text (A-Z, a-z) to ROT13-Text and vice versa. That's nothing new, you might think!?

But the feature of ROT13 is, that it opens a little fontsensitive GUI where you can put your text in a string-gadget and ROT13 displays the converted text underneath!

ROT13 can also jump to any public screen, e.g. the TERM public screen.

1.3 Copyright

ROT13 is @1995 by Björn Schotte (BOMBERSOFT).

1.5 Getting started :)

Start ROT13 from Shell or Workbench. In both cases it opens a little window on the workbench with a string-gadget and a text-gadget. ROT13 has one menu: "Project". There are 3 items:

"Jump to PubScreen..." "J":
  If you select this item, a little window opens with a listview-gadget
  where all public screens are listed in. If you double-click on one
  entry, ROT13 opens its window on the selected publicscreen. Nice, isn't
  it??
  If you don't want to select a screen, click on the closegadget of the
  window
"Information..." "I"
  Some informations about the program :)
"Quit..." "Q"
  A requester opens and asks you if you really want to quit...
Well, let's turn back to the gadgets:
Type "t" (for selecting the string-gadget) and type in "Hello" (and RETURN,
of course:). In the text-gadget ROT13 displays the following text: "Uryyb".
This is the ROT13 of "Hello". Well, type in "Uryyb" and ROT13 displays
you: "Hello". Nice, isn't it? :)
Now let's do something other:
INPUT:
         "Hello, how are you?"
OUTPUT: "Uryyb, ubj ner lbh?"
You see, all characters that aren't in those like "A"-"Z" and "a"-"z" aren't
translated, but they will be displayed in the text-gadget!!
Did you understood that? No? --- ehm....:)
