Window2Front is a tool that grabs a window and puts it in front of all the other $\,\,\leftrightarrow\,\,$ ones.

So why another 'window to front' tool ? Well, sometimes I just wanna make $\,\,\hookleftarrow\,\,$ something, no matter what.

This small util does it's job by selecting a hotkey.

Selecting the hotkey again automatically gets the next and the reverse hotkey the $\ensuremath{\,\leftarrow\,}$ previous window.

And as this program is a commodity, you can change the hotkey by changing it in \leftarrow the icon and quit it when starting twice.

Default hotkey: CTRL, Y.

Default reverse hotkey: CTRL, SHIFT, Y.

This program handles a list up to 30 windows, which should be quite enough. But if that's not enough for ya, let

know.
