It opens a window on your WB, where you have to enter your password. If it is the $\,\,\hookleftarrow\,\,$ wrong one,

the screen flashes and you get the message 'WRONG PASSWORD!'. If it's the correct \hookleftarrow password,

you get back to your WB-screen.

The window is always as big as your WB-screen and it's impossible (I think) to $\ \hookleftarrow$ reach the

WB-Screen behind the passy-window.
