Sign on registration:

The first time you load the program, it will operate up to 100 pins. You must enter your new registration number to increase the capacity beyond the 100 pin limit. On the menu, open Help then select Registration. The Registration dialog box will open. Enter your name and registration number in the space provided. Type over the existing registration number. The number must be entered exactly, it is case sensitive.

The registration number is located on the first page inside the user manual or on the back side of Disk 1. **Note:** If using on a network, you must save the registration number on your \underline{C} drive, then copy the saved .exe file over to the network drive.
