

Windows Media Presenter (Tools menu)

Windows Media Presenter for Microsoft PowerPoint 97 is a tool that helps you synchronize a PowerPoint presentation into an Advanced Streaming Format (ASF) stream. This add-in enables PowerPoint to:

- Connect with Windows Media Encoder.
- Send Uniform Resource Locator (URL) script commands to Windows Media Encoder.
- Export presentation slides.
- Create and control a PowerPoint presentation that remote users can watch over the network on their own desktop computers.

To get Help about a specific option, click    at the top of the dialog box, and then click the option.

Windows Media Presenter, Presenter Settings (Tools menu)

Selects the settings (.nse) file for a Windows Media Presenter session. Also used to start encoding the presentation.

Windows Media Presenter, Export Slides (Tools menu)

Outputs your presentation slides as JPEG images to the Web server you specify.

Windows Media Presenter, New Windows Media Encoder Settings File (Tools menu)

Creates a new settings (.nse) file for use with Windows Media Presenter. The settings file identifies the location of the Windows Media Encoder and the configuration used to encode the live stream.

Windows Media Presenter, Edit Windows Media Encoder Settings File (Tools menu)

Modifies an existing settings (.nse) file. Use this to update the location of your Windows Media Encoder, or to change the encoder configuration file used.
