HOOKER EVENING PRIMROSE

SCIENTIFIC NAME:
OENOTHERA HOOKERI

ALSO CALLED: GIANT YELLOW FLOWERED EVENING PRIMROSE AND CALIFORNIA EVENING PRIMROSE

FLOWER COLOR: YELLOW

FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: NORMALLY ONE AT END OF BRANCHES BUT OCCASIONALLY ON THE SAME PLANT
THERE MAY BE SEVERAL ON ONE END

FLOWERING TIME: MAY-OCTOBER

LEAVES: LANCET OR CANOE SHAPED

NORMAL SIZE: 18" TO 30"

NORMAL ELEVATION: 6000' TO 8000'

HABITATION: MOIST AREAS

ABUNDANCE: RARE

NOTABLE CHARACTERISTICS: HERBACEOUS WITH LEAVES ABOUT 3/4" WIDE AND 4" TO 5" LONG AND
POINTED AT EACH END WITH BRIGHT YELLOW LARGE FOUR PETAL FLOWERS

SPECIAL INTEREST: BEAUTIFUL AND PREFERS THE HIGHER ELAVATIONS AND VERY MOIST DITCHES.
