SCIENTIFIC NAME:

SIDA PROCUMBENS

ALSO CALLED: SIDA ABUTIFOLIA, PALEFACE ROSE MALLOW, SPREADING FANPETALS, AND SPREADING SIDA

FLOWER COLOR: YELLOW

FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: AT ENDS OF MOSTLY PROSTRATE BRANCHES

FLOWERING TIME: APRIL AND MAY

LEAVES: SMALL VEINED AND TOOTHED EDGED LEAVES ON RELATIVELY LONG STEMS

NORMAL SIZE: LESS THAN 12"

NORMAL ELEVATION: 2000' TO 4000'

HABITATION: EDGES OF DRY WASHES

ABUNDANCE: RARE

NOTABLE DETAILS: HERBACEOUS SMALL MULTI-STEMMED PLANT WITH UNUSUALLY LONG LEAF STEMS AND ROUND YELLOW FLOWERS

SPECIAL INTEREST: SMALLEST PRIMROSE-LIKE FLOWERS ONLY ABOUT THE SIZE OF A NICKLE
