HABITATION: HILLSIDES AND DISTURBED AREAS
ABUNDANCE: RARE

NOTABLE DETAILS: HERBACEOUS SUCCULENT PLANT WITH LARGE LEAVES AND BLUE BELL FLOWERS AND REDDISH STEMS
