ALSO CALLED: DESERT WALLFLOWER, ROUGH WALLFLOWER, AND WESTERN WALLPAPER

FLOWER COLOR: ORANGE

FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: IN BUNCHES AT ENDS OF BRANCHES

FLOWERING TIME: APRIL TO SEPTEMBER

LEAVES: ELONGATED WITH STRONG DEEP CENTER VEIN AND SHARP POINT

NORMAL SIZE: UP TO 30"

NORMAL ELEVATION: 5000' TO 9000'

HABITATION: ROADSIDES AND FOREST EDGES

ABUNDANCE: COMMON

NOTABLE DETAILS: HERBACEOUS PLANT WITH MANY BRANCHES AND BUNCHES OF LARGE FLOWERS WITH MANY ELONGATED NARROW LEAVES AND A DEEP MIDDLE VEIN.
