YELLOW TRUMPET BUSH

SCIENTIFIC NAME:
TECOMA STANS

ALSO CALLED: YELLOW TRUMPET

FLOWER COLOR: YELLOW

LEAVES: WILLOW-LIKE WITH SERRATED EDGES

FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: SEVERALLY ON SPIKES

NORMAL SIZE: 6' TO 8'

FLOWERING TIME: MAY TO SEPTEMBER

NORMAL ELEVATION: 3500' TO 5000'

HABITATION: UPPER DESERT CANYONS

ABUNDANCE: RARE BUT OFTEN USED AS AN ORNAMENTAL FOR LANDSCAPING

NOTABLE DETAILS: SERRATED LONG NARROW LEAVES AND LARGE YELLOW TRUMPET FUNNEL-LIKE FLOWERS

SPECIAL INTEREST: IT IS KNOWN TO GROW ABUNDANTLY IN THE MORE TROPICAL COUNTRIES DOWN TO CENTRAL AMERICA
