PALMER AMARANTH

SCIENTIFIC NAME:
AMARANTHUS PALMERI

ALSO CALLED: CARELESSWEED AND REDROOT

FLOWER COLOR: GREEN

FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: INCONSPICUOUS GREEN FLOWERS ON MANY STALKS

FLOWERING TIME: APRIL TO NOVEMBER

LEAVES: ON STEMS AND MOSTLY TRIANGULAR WITH STRONG VEINS

NORMAL SIZE: UP TO 4'

EDIBLE: SEEDS HAVE BEEN USED FOREVER

NORMAL ELEVATION: EVERYWHERE

HABITATION: DISTURBED AREAS

ABUNDANCE: COMMON

NOTABLE DETAILS: HERBACEOUS TALL PLANT WITH TRIANGULAR LEAVES AND MUCH DIVIDED FLOWER STALKS
