HAIRY BOWLESIA

**SCIENTIFIC NAME:**  
BOWLESIA INCANA

**ALSO CALLED:** HOARY BOWLESIA AND AMERICAN BOWLESIA

**FLOWER COLOR:** GREEN

**FLOWER ARRANGEMENT:** SEVERAL ON MINIATURE SPIKES

**FLOWERING TIME:** JANUARY TO MARCH

**LEAVES:** ON STEMS AND MOSTLY FIVE LOBED

**NORMAL SIZE:** UP TO 2'

**NORMAL ELEVATION:** BELOW 3500'

**HABITATION:** DRY WASHES IN THE SHADED SOUTH BANKS TO ESCAPE FROM TOO MUCH SUN

**ABUNDANCE:** VERY COMMON

**NOTABLE DETAILS:** HERBACEOUS FRAIL ALMOST VINY PLANT WITH LONG STEMS AND FIVE LOBED LEAVES WITH INCONSPICUOUS, ALMOST INVISIBLE, TINY FLOWERS

**SPECIAL INTEREST:** NOT WELL KNOWN, YET OVERLY PLENTIFUL
