ALSO CALLED: SCARLET BUGLER AND LITTLE BEARDTONGUE

FLOWER COLOR: RED
FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: AROUND UPPER HALF OF PLANT STEMS
FLOWERING TIME: MARCH TO JUNE
LEAVES: LONG NARROW FOLDED AT MID-VEIN
NORMAL SIZE: UP TO 3'
NORMAL ELEVATION: UP TO 4500'
HABITATION: DRY WASHES AND HILLSIDES
ABUNDANCE: COMMON

NOTABLE DETAILS: HERBACEOUS TALL WITH NARROW POINTED LEAVES AND RED BUGLE SHAPED FLOWERS
