ALSO CALLED: WHITE EVENING PRIMROSE, GUMBO LILY, LIMESTONE EVENING PRIMROSE, SAND-LILY, MORNING-LILY, AND STEMLESS PRIMROSE

FLOWER COLOR: WHITE
FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: AT ENDS OF SHORT STALKS WITH LEAVES SURROUNDING
FLOWERING TIME: MARCH TO MAY
LEAVES: VELVET SMOOTH WITH SLIGHT NOTCHES ON EDGES
NORMAL SIZE: UP TO 8"
NORMAL ELEVATION: UP TO 7500'
HABITATION: ROADSIDES AND SOMETIMES SHADED HILLSIDES
ABUNDANCE: COMMON

NOTABLE DETAILS: HERBACEOUS, SHORT, MANY LEAVED, ELONGATED, SLIGHTLY NOTCHED VELVETY LEAVES AND LARGE WHITE FLOWERS

SPECIAL INTEREST: BLOOM EARLY MORNINGS AND VERY COOL CLOUDY DAYS
