DESERT BUTTERCUP

SCIENTIFIC NAME:
RANUNCULUS CYMBALARIA

ALSO CALLED: DESERT CROWFOOT, NORTHERN SEASIDE BUTTERCUP, AND YELLOW WATER CROWFOOT

FLOWER COLOR: YELLOW
FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: AT ENDS OF TALL BARE STALKS
FLOWERING TIME: JUNE TO OCTOBER
LEAVES: SPOON SHAPED ON LONG STEMS
NORMAL SIZE: 6" UP TO 12"
NORMAL ELEVATION: 5000' TO 8500'
HABITATION: SPRING FED SPRINGS
ABUNDANCE: COMMON

NOTABLE DETAILS: HERBACEOUS SPREADING PLANT WITH BRIGHT YELLOW RAY FLOWERS WITH TALL GREEN CONE IN THE MIDDLE WITH SPOON LIKE LEAVES

SPECIAL INTEREST: PLANT FOUND NEAR MT. UNION IN THE BRADSHAW MOUNTAINS.
