FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: CLUSTERS OF TINY WHITE FLOWERS ON BARE STALKS
FLOWERING TIME: FEBRUARY TO OCTOBER
LEAVES: FINGER-LIKE
NORMAL SIZE: 10" TO 16"
NORMAL ELEVATION: 4000' TO 8000'
HABITATION: OPEN AREAS OF SEMI-SHADE
ABUNDANCE: COMMON

NOTABLE DETAILS: HERBACEOUS PLANT WITH BASAL FINGERLING LEAVES AND CLUSTER OF MINIATURE WHITE FLOWERS IN CLUSTERS AT ENDS OF BARE FLOWER STALKS

SPECIAL INTEREST: SOMETIMES FOUND WITH RED FLOWERS
