**FLOWER COLOR:** GREEN  
**FLOWER ARRANGEMENT:** SMALL CLUSTER OF TINY FLOWERS  
**FLOWERING TIME:** APRIL TO MAY  
**LEAVES:** TINY NARROW LEAVES COVERING BRANCHES  
**NORMAL SIZE:** 100' TO 200'  
**NORMAL ELEVATION:** 6500' TO 10000'  
**HABITATION:** HIGH MOUNTAIN SIDES  
**ABUNDANCE:** COMMON

**NOTABLE DETAILS:** TALLEST TREES IN ARIZONA WITH TINY LEAVES AND PINE CONES WITH SPURS

**SPECIAL INTEREST:** SEEING THE PINE CONES IS OFTEN DIFFICULT BECAUSE THEY ARE SO TALL, BUT THE GROUND BELOW SHOWS THE INTERESTING FEATURE OF SPURS ON THE EDGES OF EACH LOBE OF THE CONE
