BAHIA DISSECTA

**ALSO CALLED:** WILD CHRYSANTHEMUM, RAGLEAF, AND YELLOW RAGWEED

**FLOWER COLOR:** YELLOW

**FLOWERING TIME:** AUGUST TO SEPTEMBER

**FLOWER ARRANGEMENT:** SINGLE FLOWERS AT ENDS OF SHORT BRANCHED STALKS

**LEAVES:** DEEPLY LOBED LIKE FINGERS

**NORMAL SIZE:** 24" TO 48"

**NORMAL ELEVATION:** 4000' TO 7000'

**HABITATION:** ROADSIDES AND FLAT HIGH CANYON FLATS

**ABUNDANCE:** COMMON

**NOTABLE DETAILS:** TALL PLANT WITH YELLOW FLOWERS AND DEEPLY LOBED FINGER-LIKE LEAVES

**SPECIAL INTEREST:** THE FLOWER PETALS ARE UNUSUAL HAVING FOLDED APPEARANCE AS THOUGH THEY WERE FOLDED IN THREE AND STRAIGHTENED OUT.
