

**COMMON NAME:**  
BIRDSFOOT LOTUS

**SCIENTIFIC NAME:**  
LOTUS CORNICULATUS

**ALSO CALLED:** BIRDSFOOT TREFOIL, EGGS-AND-BACON, AND BIRD'S FOOT DEER VETCH

**FLOWER COLOR:** YELLOW  
**FLOWER ARRANGEMENT:** SEVERALLY ON ENDS OF BRANCHES  
**FLOWERING TIME:** APRIL TO AUGUST  
**LEAVES:** SPACED ALONG THE BRANCHES IN THREES  
**NORMAL SIZE:** 8" BUT MAY CLIMB TO 4' OR MORE LIKE A VINE  
**NORMAL ELEVATION:** 4000' TO 8000'  
**HABITATION:** STREAM BANKS OF SPRING-FED WATER WAYS  
**ABUNDANCE:** RARE

**NOTABLE DETAILS:** BRIGHT YELLOW PEA FLOWER TRAILING OR CLIMBING OVER BOULDERS ON VINE-LIKE BRANCHES AND THREE LEAF CLUSTERS SPREAD EVENLY ALL OVER
