SCOULER'S ST. JOHNSWORT

SCIENTIFIC NAME:
HYPERICUM FORMOSUM

ALSO CALLED: SOUTHWESTERN ST. JOHN'S WORT AND WESTERN ST. JOHN'S WORT

FLOWER COLOR: YELLOW
FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: SEVERALLY AT TOP OF EACH BRANCH
FLOWERING TIME: MAY TO AUGUST
LEAVES: OVAL WITH SMALLER OVAL ABOVE EACH AXIS
NORMAL SIZE: UP TO 36"
NORMAL ELEVATION: 5000' TO 9000'
HABITATION: SOGGY BOGS AND OTHER MOSTLY MOIST MEADOWS
ABUNDANCE: RARE

NOTABLE DETAILS: TWO SIZES OF LEAVES AND BRIGHT YELLOW FLOWER
