ALSO CALLED: MURPHEY'S AGAVE AND MURPHEY'S CENTURY PLANT

FLOWER COLOR: PINK

FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: CLUMPS OF MANY UPRIGHT FLOWERS ABOVE A NEARLY HORIZONTAL ARM

FLOWERING TIME: APRIL TO JUNE

LEAVES: WIDE TO NEEDLE POINT WITH SERRATED POINTS ON EDGES

NORMAL SIZE: 15' TO 20'

NORMAL ELEVATION: 2500' TO 4000'

HABITATION: HILLSIDE AND CANYON WALLS

ABUNDANCE: COMMON WIDE AREA

NOTABLE DETAILS: PINK STAMENS, WHICH MAKE IT LOOK LIKE IT HAS PINK FLOWERS BUT ACTUALLY IT HAS YELLOW-GREEN FLOWERS
