FLOWER COLOR: PINK

FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: TYPICAL MIMOSA CLUBS OF MINI-FLOWERS

FLOWERING TIME: MAY TO SEPTEMBER

LEAVES: SMALL COMPOUND BIPINNATE LEAVES

NORMAL SIZE: 4' TO 6'

NORMAL ELEVATION: 4000' TO 6000'

HABITATION: OPEN HILLSIDES

ABUNDANCE: COMMON

NOTABLE DETAILS: PINK FLOWERS AND SMALL COMPOUND LEAVES

SPECIAL INTEREST: PINK FLOWERS ARE TOTALLY UNUSUAL. THESE PLANTS ARE PRIMARILY FOUND SOUTH OF TUCSON.
