### 1.2 start

Before you start, start the program Copy\_CD\_1.3.  
This copies all the needed libraries, data's etc. to your bootdisk.

### 1.3 assign

Before you start, double-click on the program Assign\_CD\_>2MB if you have more than 2 MB's of memory, and Assign\_CD\_<2MB if you have less than 2 MB's. This program adds all the needed files, libraries etc. to your system's memory, finds the needed paths and more.

### 1.10 Global information

Global Information

ViewMenu is the program from EuroCD for using all different kinds of files, i.e. pictures, samples, modules, documents, etc.

ViewMenu does not show the files itself, but starts other programs that are specified per file-type in the .info-file of the file that is to be shown.

In the tooltypes of the file that is shown, you can specify a name. You always enter ViewMenu as the default tool. When double-clicking the file's icon, ViewMenu will be started. ViewMenu will then look what file-type has called it (using the name specified in tooltypes) and will then start the specified program to show the file.

With the program ViewMenu.Prefs you can add or change filetypes and the programs that are called by them.

This means that using a simple modification in ViewMenu.Prefs, you can change the display-method for alle filetypes on EuroCD. For instance, you can make sure that all pictures on EuroCD will in future be shown using a CyberGraphix viewer, or that all modules will be played using your favourite module-player.

### 1.11 Location of the files

Location of the files

When assigning EuroCD, the ViewMenu files will be copied to the user's system. ViewMenu itself will be copied to the C: drawer, ViewMenu.Prefs to the sys:Prefs drawer, and ViewMenu.data to the env: drawer. When the files already exist there, the copy sequence will be skipped.

## 1.12 ViewMenu.Prefs

### ViewMenu.Prefs

When you start ViewMenu.Prefs, you will see a window with a number of gadgets. We will now explain the function of these gadgets.

#### Tool Type

Here you can specify the name of the filetype that is to be added or changed. As soon as ViewMenu finds this name in the tooltypes of the selected file, it will show the file using the program that is associated with the filetype.

#### Path

Here you will find the command that is associated with the specific filetype. For instance, when you want a picture to be shown with the program VT, that is in the viewers drawer on your hard disk volume dh1:, this line will show as follows:

#### F

Shows a filerequester, with which you can easily select the program of your choice.

#### DEL ENTRY

Removes a filetype and the associated data.

#### NEW ENTRY

Cleans the fields for Tool Type and Path, so that new entries can be made.

#### I<

Jumps to the first filetype in the list.

#### <<

Selects the previous filetype.

#### >>

Selects the next filetype.

#### >I

Jumps to the last filetype in the list.

**ABOUT**

Gives a short info about ViewMenu.

**SAVE**

Saves the entered data.

**QUIT**

Exits the program.
