The menu that you see may differ from this, we add new databases and submenus whenever we find something that will be of interest to users. But the general format and shortcuts should be the same.

?	Provide a summary of data menu commands.
<number></number>	Type the number of your choice from the menu to go to that item or submenu. a '/' at the end of a line indicates that there is a submenu; a name in upper case indicates that choice will take you straight to that database.
(g)o	Go to a database. Type "g <return>" to be prompted for a database name or shown a list of available databases. Or type "g NAME" where "NAME" is the name of the database you want to use (usually all in upper case letters) to</return>
(I)ist	jump straight to that database and skip the menus. Lists the short names (see "NAME" above under (g)o) of all the available databases
(q)uit	Type 'q' to quit to the Main Command menu at any point of the submenus.
(u)p	Type 'u' to move up one level in the menu system.
