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## ZAMPATTI, Carla Maria (1943-)

Born in 1943 in Italy, she came to Australia in 1950 with her family. They moved to a mining town in Western Australia and Zampatti spent her childhood and teenage years there. She went to Sydney in 1963, having obtained a job as a clothing store clerk. Her work led her into designing blouses, and from this position Zampatti launched her own label and company in 1965. Since this time she has proved her design capability and flexibility, her Carla Zampatti label maintaining its status as a highly regarded Australian fashion business for over 30 years. She has over 30 retail stores and was made Qantas *Business Weekly* Businesswoman of the Year in 1980-81.

## **ZELMAN, Alberto (1874-1927)**

Born in Melbourne in 1874 of an Italian musician immigrant, Zelman was something of a prodigy on violin, performing in public from the age of six. He became deeply involved with the city's musical scene, conducting, teaching at the University Conservatorium, directing choral works, and in 1912 marrying soprano Maude Harrington. The couple went to Britain and Europe in 1922, where Zelman conducted the Berlin Philharmonic and the London Symphony Orchestra. He died in Melbourne in 1927.
