To run the ATTICA Demo Disc, you will require:

Minimum specification:

MPC1 or equivalent 16 MHz 80386SX (486 highly recommended) 2Mb RAM (4MB highly recommended) DOS 3.1 or later Microsoft Windows 3.1 or later 256 colour 640x480 SVGA display MPC-Compatible CD-ROM drive Sound card and mouse Microsoft CD-ROM Extensions 2.2 or later

In order to fully appreciate this demo, a 486 PC with an audio board and headphones or speakers is required. However, the demo may also be run without sound.

1) The ATTICA Demonstration Disc is designed to run specifically in 640 x 480 resolution with 256 colours. If you have trouble running the demo; if it runs slowly, the colours look odd, or you receive error messages relating to your video driver, you may want to change your display driver settings. To do this, go to Program Manager and start Windows Setup in the "main" program group. Change the display driver to one that uses 256 colours. You will need to change the resolution to 640x480 for better performance.

2) You may receive an error message that says:

Director Player Error: Unable to find movie named <driveletter>:\movies\ ww2.MMM.

This may also mean that you do not have enough memory to run the ATTICA Demo Disc. Ensure that Windows is running in "enhanced" mode. Try closing all applications that are open and then run the demo again.

3) You should disable any screen savers prior to the demonstration. If a screen saver becomes active while the cursor is on screen, when returning to the demo the cursor will be invisible. Starting and stopping the movie again restores the cursor.
