## Description

**Naf - Not Another Font Viewer** - is an easy to use utility that provides, in a single window, a way to view all the fonts installed on your PC. Font faces can be compared, styles applied and viewed, different point sizes selected, your own text entered or pasted, and a sample sent to print.

## Use

Select a font from the font list to automatically display that font in the text display area. Change the appearance of the selected font by clicking on one of the style buttons in the toolbar. Click the print button to print a sample of the selected font.

## Toolbar Reference



Exits Naf.



Displays a character set sample for the selected font.



Displays an editable text sample for the selected font. You can enter or paste your own text in the text display area. Right click the text display area for a pop-up menu.



Prints a preformatted character set and text sample for the selected font.



Displays text in bold.



Displays text in italics.



Displays text in underline.



Displays text in strikeout.



Displays font in the selected point size.

## Installation

Naf is supplied in a zip file which should contain:

NAF.EXE    the Naf application

NAF.RTF this document.

To install, copy or move both files to a directory of your choice then create a shortcut for NAF.EXE.

To uninstall, delete both files and the directory, if empty. Naf does not create any INI files or other stuff that needs to be removed.
