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## Plant Type

This drop-down selection box provides a choice of the type of plant to be displayed during screen saver operation. The current selection is displayed in the window. Additional selections are available in a drop down window.

## Color Scheme

Used to select the color scheme with which the plant images are drawn. The color of the plant to be drawn next is selected randomly from within the color scheme selected.

**Note:** This control is disabled if color choice is unavailable for the plant type selected.

## Background Tone

Used to select the background tone.onto which the plant images are drawn. The tone is graded from the bottom of the screen (darker) to the top (lighter).

## Delay

Sets the delay time that the plant images are displayed after drawing. **Out of the Garden** will erase these images and begin another drawing after the dealy time has elapsed.

## Number of Plants

Sets the number of plants displayed during screen saver operation.

## Password Protected

Checking the **Password** check box enables the password protection feature. In this mode, Windows (™) requests a password before restoring the screen from the operating screen saver.

## Select a Plant Type

To select the type of plant to be displayed during screen saver operation, you must:

1. Click with the mouse on the arrow to the right of the window showing the currently selected plant type.

A list of available selections will be displayed in the drop down window.

2. Select the plant type you want from the list displayed.

Your selection will appear in the window as the current selection, replacing the old one.

3. Close the list by clicking on the arrow a second time or selecting another input control.

Your selection now is the current selection.

## Select a Color Scheme

You can select the color scheme used to draw the plants during screen saver operation.

To select the color scheme, you must:

1. Click with the mouse on the arrow to the right of the window showing the currently selected color scheme.

A list of available selections will be displayed in the drop down window.

2. Select the color scheme you want from the list displayed.

Your selection will appear in the window as the current selection, replacing the old one.

3. Close the list by clicking on the arrow a second time or selecting another input control.

Your selection now is the current selection.

**Note:** The drop-down selection box will be disabled if a color scheme choice is not appropriate to the plant type selected.

## Set the Background Tone

You can set the background tone on which **Out of the Garden** displays the plant images. The tone is graded from a dark color at the bottom of the screen to a light color at the top.

To set the background tone, you must:

1. Click with the mouse on the arrow to the right of the window showing the currently selected background tone.

A list of available selections will be displayed in the drop down window.

2. Select the background tone you want from the list displayed.

Your selection will appear in the window as the current selection, replacing the old one.

3. Close the list by clicking on the arrow a second time or selecting another input control.

Your selection now is the current selection.

## Set the Time Delay

You can set the time that **Out of the Garden** pauses after drawing a screen full of plants. This time delay is introduced so that you can admire the beauty of the display. **Out of the Garden** will erase the display before beginning a new set of plants.

To set the time delay, you must:

1. Click on the associated edit box or tab to it with the keyboard to activate the edit mode.

The edit box will highlight the current entry.

2. Type in a new number for the delay.

3. Select another control or close the dialog box to exit the edit mode.

## Set the Number of Plants Displayed

You can set the number of plants that **Out of the Garden** displays at a time.

To set the number of plants, you must:

1. Click on the associated edit box or tab to it with the keyboard to activate the edit mode.

The edit box will highlight the current entry.

2. Type in a new value for the number of plants displayed.

3. Select another control or close the dialog box to exit the edit mode.

## Enable Password Protection

To make use of the password protection facility built into Windows (™) 3.1 to support screen savers, click the checkbox labeled Password Protected. You can also **Tab** to it from the keyboard and press the **Space** bar to activate or deactivate it.

The button labeled Set Password will be activated when the check box is check and the password can be entered or changed by clicking this button.

## Set the Screen Saver Password

To enter a new password or change an old one, you must:

1. Click the check box labeled Password Protected to enable password protection.

The button labeled Set Password will be activated.

2. Click on the Set Password button.

A dialog box labeled **Change Password** will appear.

The dialog box asks for the Old Password, if one is in effect, and the New Password to be entered. It will also ask you to retype the new one to confirm it. If there is no current password in effect, the Old Password edit box will be inactive.

Select **OK** to save the new password or **Cancel** to exit the dialog box without making and changes to the previous password, if any.
