Setup

Everytime Total Screensavers 98 is run it checks to see if the following files are installed on your computers. If any of the files are not detected a Setup Window will pop up advising you to install them now. The following files are needed for the Screensavers to run properly.

- Vbrun300.dll
- Vb40016.dll
- Vb40032.dll
- Msvbvm50.dll

Why Do I Need VBRun Files for the Screensavers to work?

You must have the following VBRUN files installed on your computer system to be able to preview and run some of the Screensavers. Because some of the screensavers were developed using Visual Basic which is a program tool and compiler which is similar to Visual C++. If the screensavers were developed with Visual Basic they require these files to work. If you have programs installed on your computer that were developed using Visual Basic you probably already have these files on your computer.

Can I Install These Files Later?

You may skip installing these files now and install them later from Total Screensaver's 98 main Menu. It is advised that you should install them now because if the files are not detected the Setup Window will pop-up advising you that you are missing files.
