When you purchase the Bohemian Net software suite, **you are the Seller**. If you have goods and/or services you want to sell on-line, all you need to do is:

- 1. Obtain a copy of Bohemian Net software suite.
- 2. Set up your on-line store using Bohemian Net server
- 3. Create a Storefront image and stock goods and services in your store using $\underline{\text{Bohemian Net}}$ $\underline{\text{author}}$
- 4. Distribute your custom <u>Bohemian Net browser</u> to Buyers and let them browse through your on-line store.
- 5. Take orders for your goods and services using Bohemian Net orders
- 6. Process Payment from Buyers
- 7. <u>Deliver</u> goods and/or services to Buyers

- 4. Make <u>payment</u> for your goods and/or services.

Introduction to Bohemian Net software suite

The Bohemian Net Software Suite enables the on-line transaction of goods and services using <u>standard</u> PC computers, modems and telephone lines.

Anybody with a PC, modem and phone line can sell (or give) their goods and services to any other person also having a PC, modem and phone line.

The Bohemian Net Software Suite consists of four modules:

Bohemian Net author

Create and import your own custom <u>Storefront Graphic</u>. Define <u>Category Hotspots</u> within this image map that indicate the categories of products you have to offer. Add products to each of these category hotspots to make them available on your customized Bohemian Net server. Capture text and images to provide details on each product.

Bohemian Net server

Connect a standard modem and telephone line to your computer. The Bohemian Net server software will then make your on-line store and products available to the next Bohemian Net browser to dialup your system.

Bohemian Net browser

Once you own a copy of the Bohemian Net software suite, you can distribute royalty free copies of your custom Bohemian Net browser to potential customers. They can even call your Bohemian Net server and <u>download a free copy</u>. Using the Bohemian Net browser, customers will call your Bohemian Net server (store) and browse through goods and/or services you are offering. They can then purchase items from you and engage you in <u>email</u> conversations including attachments.

Bohemian Net orders

Process <u>quotes and purchase</u> orders received by your Bohemian Net server. Manages open orders, shipped orders, backorders, Inventory, Client information and email.

Bohemian Net author

If you own a copy of the Bohemian Net software suite, you can:

- 1. Install your own custom graphic storefront image.
- 2. Create hotspot categories used to provide access to your goods and/or services.
- 3. Customize the column headings for your category result list grid.
- 4. Stock your virtual store by adding goods and/or services including text and images.
- 5. Determine beginning inventory and on-order quantities.
- 6. Determine if items are available by freight or download.
- 6. Automatically update your virtual store so that the next person calling in will be able to view your updates.

You can use the browser to dailup a variety of Bohemian Net servers and browse through the goods and/or services they are offering.

The Bohemian Net browser is a royalty free software program included when you purchase a copy of the Bohemian Net software suite (Author, Server, Orders and Browser) and create your own virtual on-line store.

When you are ready to sell products and services on-line, simply distribute the Bohemian Net browser to potential customers who own a standard PC computer, modem and telephone line.

Customers can then dialup your custom Bohemian Net server. Once logged in, they can browse through the products and services you are offering.

They can then submit requests for quotation and submit purchase orders for your goods. In addition, they can send and receive email, including attachments.

Installing the Bohemian Net browser

Installing from floppy disk:

- 1. Insert the floppy disk into an available floppy disk drive
- 2. Use the Windows Run command to execute the SETUP.EXE program on the disk. e.g. If the installation floppy is put in the a: drive, click on the File menu (or Startup with WIN95), click on Run, enter a:\setup, and click on OK
- 3. Follow the installation instructions that appear.
- 4. Be sure to enter the registration information correctly so you will not have to go through the trouble of changing it later.

Installing by downloading from our home page or our Bohemian Net: (<u>obtaining a copy online</u>)

- 1. Download a copy of BOHEMIAN.EXE from our WWW home page or Bohemian Net central (415)388-4819.
- 2. After you have downloaded BOHEMIAN.EXE, use the Windows Run command to execute the file. This will unzip the Bohemian Net browser setup files into the directory where BOHEMIAN.EXE is located.
- 3. Use the Windows Run command to execute the SETUP.EXE program unzipped into the same directory.
- 4. Follow the installation instructions that appear.
- 5. Be sure to enter the registration information correctly so you will not have to go through the trouble of changing it later.

NOTE: After installation, all the installation files will be removed from your system.

Program Upgrades

New and 3rd-party applications

Additional Bohemian Net applications, or applications from 3rd-party developers which enhance the capability of the Bohemian Net software product line.

As a registered user of Bohemian Net products, you will be notified of all these program revisions and how to obtain them.

Updates - On-line

In some cases, when you dial up a Bohemian Net server, you will be updated with a new copy of the Bohemian Net browser automatically. If you have an earlier version of Bohemian Net browser, a message will display telling you that an update is being sent. After you receive the update, you will need to exit your Bohemian Net browser and load it again to activate the update.

The main screen of the Bohemian Net browser is the display area of the Bohemian Net online store. This storefront graphic changes depending on the Bohemian Net server you are calling. If you decide to purchase the Bohemian Net software suite, you can create your own custom storefront graphic so that it will display when a Bohemian Net browser calls. A list of available

Bohemian Nets can be stored in your Bohemian Net phone Book.

Dialing up a Bohemian Net server

You can dial up a server by clicking on the File menu, then clicking on Dialup. You can also initiate a call to the server by clicking on a Hotspot Category or any other command that requests information from a server.

Bohemian Net Phone Book

To dial up a Bohemian Net server other than the one currently displayed, use the Phone Book. It contains the names and numbers of other Bohemian Nets. You can add to this list and get updates to the list. You access the phone book by clicking on the View menu and then clicking on Phone book. You can also click on the Phone Book icon in the tool speed bar When you highlight a name and click on the Select button, the browser will load that Bohemian Net. More on the Phone Book.

Storefront Graphic

The storefront graphic appears when you dialup a Bohemian Net server. This graphic is designed by the owner of that server and provides access to the goods and services available on that Bohemian Net. <u>More on the Storefront Graphic</u>.

Hotspot Categories

The storefront graphic contains Hotspot Categories defined by the owner of the Bohemian Net server. Each Hotspot provides access to the goods and services available for that Hotspot as designed by the owner of that server. Pass your cursor over the storefront graphic and yellow notes will appear letting you know what each Hotspot Category contains. If you click on a Hotspot Category, the browser will send a search query to the Bohemian Net server requesting a list of available goods and/or services. The list will be sent to the browser and displayed in the Result List. These lists then provide access to specific product information and ordering. More on Hotspot Categories.

Freetext Search

To execute a general search, initiate a freetext search on all information in the Bohemian Net server you are calling. Click on the View menu, then click on Text Search. You can also click on the Freetext icon in the tool speed bar. More on Freetext Search.

Email

To send email to the owner of the Bohemian Net server, click on the View menu, then click on Email. You can also click on the Email button in the tool speed bar. The email screen that appears will also provide access to email responses and attachments. <u>More on Email.</u>

Modem Setup

To reconfigure your modem preferences, click on the Options menu, then click on Modem Setup. <u>More on Modem Setup</u>

Account Setup

To view and reset your account information and preferences, click on the Options menu, then click on Account Setup. <u>More on Account Setup</u>.

Password

Click on the Options menu, then click on Change Password to change your password for a Bohemian Server you are calling. You must be logged onto a server before this button is enabled. More on <u>Passwords</u>.

Registering with the Bohemian Net Server

After installing the Bohemian Net browser, a screen will appear with a Start button on it.

IMPORTANT: If you have not correctly filled out the account data that you were prompted for during installation, now is the time to correct the information before you register. This information will be difficult to change later, and you may miss out on valuable program_revisions. You can change your account information by clicking on the Options menu, then clicking on Account Setup.

Click on the Start button to dialup the main Bohemian Net server and register.

You will need to register with each different Bohemian Net server that you call. A list of these

servers is located in the **Bohemian Net Phone Book**

The first time you dialup a Bohemian Net server, you enter a <u>password</u> and then verify the password. A special subdirectory is then created on your hard disk drive under the directory you installed the browser in. A <u>storefront graphic</u> and other system update files are then transferred to that subdirectory. The next time you dialup the same server, enter the password once and the storefront graphic will appear.

Passwords

A unique password is required when a Bohemian Net browser dials up and a Bohemian Net server. The first time the browser calls a server, a password must be created and confirmed. The next time the browser calls the same server, the password is required to log on. This password is linked to the account data for the browser and is stored on the server.

Changing your password

To change your password, you must be already connected to the appropriate Bohemian Net server. You can use a different password for each Bohemian Net server, but this is not recommended.

Click on the options menu and then click on Change password.

Enter your new password and confirm it.

Be sure to develop a way to remember your password, because you will not be able to log on to the Bohemian Net server without it.

Browsing via Hotspots

When you use the Bohemian Net browser to dialup a Bohemian Net server, a <u>Storefront Graphic</u> will appear. This graphic contains Hotspot Categories which provide access to the goods and/or services available on that server.

As you move the cursor over the surface of the graphic, yellow stickies appear showing the categories of goods and/or services available.

Click on a Hotspot with the left mouse button to send a search request to the Bohemian Net server. If you are not already connected, the browser will dial the appropriate server number.

A Result List for that category will then appear with a list of goods and/or services available.

Review the Result List to get specific information on the available goods and services.

Browsing via Freetext Search

Do a Freetext Search when you have something specific in mind you want to search for.

Click on the View menu, then click on Text Search. You can also click on the Freetext icon on the toolbar.

Enter the string of information you want to search for.

Click on OK

A Result List for that category will then appear with a list goods and/or services available. This may take some time, since freetext searches look through all sources of information on the system.

Review the Result List to get specific information on available goods and services.

Viewing Result Lists

The Result List displays appropriate goods and/or services when you are <u>Browsing via Hotspots</u> or <u>Browsing via Freetext Search</u>.

The list contains all the goods and/or services meeting your request that are available on the Bohemian Net server you are connected to. This spreadsheet provides a powerful way to review and compare available information.

Sorting by Column

The information in rows can be sorted by clicking on any column heading. This is convenient for comparing prices and other characteristics of different items.

Searching for information by Column

To freetext search for specific information contained within any column, highlight the column and click on the right mouse button. Enter the search information and click on Ok. The first item meeting the search criteria will be highlighted.

Go Back button

Click on this button to return to the previously displayed screen. You can also click on the left arrow icon on the toolbar to get the same result. Clicking on the Home icon on the toolbar will take you back to the Storefront Image.

Get Details button

Highlight an item, then double-click to display the <u>product information and image</u> for that Item. You can also drag and drop items onto this button to display details about them.

Place Order button

Adds a highlighted item to the currently open order form. You can also drag and drop items onto this button to add them to the currently open order.

Check Order button

Displays the current open order form.

To print the Result List, click on the File menu and then click on Print You can also click on the print icon on the toolbar.

Viewing Product Information and Images

While <u>Viewing Result Lists</u>, you can request specific information about a product. This is done by highlighting an item, then double-clicking on it. You can also drag and drop items onto the Get Details button.

The following information will be displayed:

Comment

A comment from the owner of the Bohemian Net server about the particular item you are looking at.

Description

A description of the product or service you have requested information about. This is the same description that shows in the Result List

Other fields

Two other fields of information are supplied depending on how the Bohemian Net server was authored.

Price

The price being asked for the product or service.

Quantity

The quantity of the product currently available from the Bohemian Net server. Note that this amount can change depending on the purchases of other Bohemian Net browsers currently calling in to the server. It should be considered a report of quantity available at the time you requested the information.

Text

A body of text describing the product or service in more detail. This text can be cut and pasted to another application.

Go Back button

Click on this button to return to the previously displayed screen. You can also click on the left arrow icon on the toolbar to get the same result. Clicking on the Home icon on the toolbar will take you back to the Storefront Image.

View Item button

Click on this button to display an image of the product or service. If no image is available, this button will be disabled. After a short delay, an image will appear. Larger images will take longer to transfer. You can cancel the transfer of an image by clicking on the cancel button that appears. Make sure that your display is configured for at least 256-colors, otherwise the image will be crude.

To print the text and image, click on the File menu and then click on Print You can also click on the print icon on the toolbar

Printing Product Information and Images

To print the text and image, click on the File menu and then click on Print You can also click on the print icon on the toolbar.

Order Form

The order form is used to assemble items of interest to obtain a quote for them, or to purchase them.

When you load the Bohemian Net browser, an open order is created. As you <u>browse via category hotspots</u> or <u>browse via freetext search</u>, you will run into items of interest.

If you have filled in the prepared by field in the <u>Account Setup Screen</u>, that name will appear in the By: field of the order. Otherwise you can enter any name you wish.

Add items to the open order while <u>viewing Result Lists</u> and while <u>viewing Product Information</u> and <u>Images</u>. You will be alerted if any items will be <u>Backordered</u>.

Billing and Shipping Information tab

Click on the Billing and Shipping tab to complete the <u>Payment Method and Address</u> and the <u>Shipping Method and Address</u>

After an order has been shipped and you <u>trace</u> the order, the waybill number and ship date will appear as part of the shipping information.

Comments tab

Click on the comments tab to add <u>comments to the Seller</u> and to read comments from the Seller. Comments from the Seller will appear after you send the order and receive back a confirmation.

History tab

When you save and order, request a quote, purchase an order, or trace an order; a copy of the order is recorded in the grid in the <u>History</u> tab.

Qty

The quantity of each item originally ordered

Ship

The quantity of each item that is being shipped. This column only shows up on a confirmed order. It shows the quantity available for shipment.

B/O

The difference between the quantity ordered and quantity being shipped. This column only shows up on a confirmed order. It shows the quantity that will be backordered due to insufficient inventory.

Description

The description of the item being purchased

Unit \$

The unit price of the item being purchased

Fxt \$

The quantity ordered multiplied times the unit price

Subtotal

The total price of the items ordered.

Sales tax

The amount of sales tax charged by the Seller

Shipping

The amount of shipping charged by the Seller

Order total

The total of the items ordered, sales tax, and shipping charges.

Request Quote button

Click to <u>obtain a Quote</u> for the items listed in the order form. The order will be saved and a request for quote will be sent to, and confirmed by, the server.

Purchase button

Click to <u>purchase products and services</u> listed in the order form. The order will be saved and a purchase request will be sent to, and confirmed by, the server.

Order Name:

This field contains the name of the order, which you will be prompted for when you save the order. You will want to enter a purchase order number or some characters that will help you identify the order in the future.

By:

This field contains the name of the person preparing the order. It will default to the name in the <u>Account Setup</u> dialog which you can access from the Options menu

Date:

This field contains the date the order was originated.

Confirmation # and date

After your purchase request has been received by the server, you will receive an <u>order confrmation</u> and will then have an opportunity to <u>accept or cancel the order</u>. The date shown is the date of confirmation by the server.

Order Status:

This field will display the status of the order. An order can be Open, Quote, Shipped, or Backordered.

Go Back button

Click on this button to return to the previously displayed screen. You can also click on the left arrow icon on the toolbar to get the same result. Clicking on the Home icon on the toolbar will take you back to the Storefront Image.

Edit button

Click to edit a highlighted item. You can change the quantity you want to order of the item.

Delete button

Click to delete a highlighted item from the list.

New button

Click to clear the existing order and create a new one. You will be asked if you want to save the open order first.

Save button

Click to save the open order. You will be prompted for a name for the order. A copy of the order will be saved to the grid in the <u>History tab</u>.

Adding Items to the Order Form

First you need to do a <u>Hotspot Category</u> or <u>Freetext</u> search.

Items can then be added to the <u>order form</u> in two ways:

- 1. When $\underline{\text{viewing the Result List}}$, highlight an item of interest and click on the Place Order button, or drag and drop the item onto the button.
- 2. When <u>viewing Product Information</u>, click on the Place Order button.

Obtaining a Quote for Goods and Services

Fill out the Order Form with a list of goods and services you want to request a quotation for.

Click on the Quote button to send the request for quotation (RFQ) to the Bohemian Net server.

Receipt of your quote will be confirmed.

The owner of the Bohemian Net server is able to manage all quotes received. You can $\underline{\text{trace}}$ the response to your quote request. Use the Status button in the $\underline{\text{History}}$ tab to determine if a response has been made to your request.

<u>Email</u> or the telephone can also be used to request and respond to quotes.

You can convert a quote to a purchase by displaying the quote and then clicking on the purchase button.

Purchasing Goods and Services

Fill out the Order Form with a list of goods and services you want to purchase.

Click on the Purchase button to send the request for purchase to the Bohemian Net server.

Receipt of your purchase request will be confirmed.

The owner of the Bohemian Net server is able to manage all purchase requests received. You can <u>trace</u> the response to your purchase request to see if it has been shipped. Use the Trace button in the <u>History</u> tab to determine if a response has been made to your purchase.

Payment Method and Address

The operator of the Bohemian Net server you dialup determines the payment methods your can use for that server. These will be transferred to you as you log onto each server you call.

You can select one of these available payment methods and include a billing address for each order you create.

The default values of the billing address information will be the information you have supplied during registration, or have updated using the <u>Account Setup Screen</u>.

Change the billing address information if you want to bill the order to another location.

The default values of the payment method will be the information you have supplied using the Account Setup Screen. If no default has been set up, you will need to enter this information before purchasing the order.

Click on the combo box and select one of the available payment methods if you want a change.

Note: If you do not enter a payment method, when you purchase an order, a message will appear requiring an entry before proceeding.

Depending on the payment method you select, <u>Credit Authorization</u> will need to take place before your order can be shipped. The order will also be subject to appropriate sales tax and shipping charges which will be added by the operator of the Bohemian Net server.

Credit Authorization

After your order has been $\underline{\text{confirmed}}$, but prior to $\underline{\text{shipment}}$, your credit must be authorized by the Bohemian Net server.

Different Bohemian Net servers will offer different <u>payment methods</u>. Some will require receipt of payment prior to shipment. Others will ship on account, via COD or by credit card. Each Bohemian Net server will specify which payment methods are available.

Purchase Credits

Purchase credits can be offered by a Bohemian Net server as a payment method. Purchase credits can be earned, result from a credit from a <u>Return Merchandise Authorization</u> (RMA), or can be earned.

If you are offered purchase credits, a recap of your credit limit, credits used and credits available will be available in the daily message that displays when you log onto a Bohemian Net server. Display the daily message by clicking on the View menu, then clicking on Daily Message.

Shipping Method and Address

The operator of the Bohemian Net server you dialup determines the shipping methods your can use for that server. These will be transferred to you as you log onto each server you call.

You can select one of these available shipping methods and include a shipping address for each order you create.

A shipping method and a shipping address can be specified for each order you create.

The default values of the shipping information will be the information you have supplied during registration, or have updated using the <u>Account Setup Screen</u>.

Change the shipping address if you want to send the product you order to another location.

The default values of the shipping method will be the information you have supplied using the Account Setup Screen.

Click on the combo box and select a new shipping method if you want a change.

Note: If you do not enter a shipping method, when you purchase an order, a message will appear requiring an entry before proceeding.

Backorder Notification during Purchase

When you are Viewing a Product Hit List,

Each time you add an item to the <u>Order Form</u>, the current available inventory of the item will be checked against the quantity you are ordering. If you are ordering more than are available, a message will appear warning you of potential backorders.

IMPORTANT - keep in mind that the backorder status of an item is determined at the time you make your request to <u>view product information</u> for an item. These backorder values may change, while you are assembling your order, depending on the purchase activity of other browsers connected to the same Bohemian Net server.

Each time you change the quantity of an item on the Order Form, you will also be notified of potential backorders.

In addition, when you click on the Purchase button to execute an order, you will also be notified of potential backorders.

When you receive an <u>order confirmation</u>, the Bohemian Net server will send the exact backorder status of each item in your order. At the same time, it will reserve the quantities you are ordering until you either accept or cancel the order.

You can <u>accept or Cancel an orders</u> at this time. Once you accept the order, you will need to take up any changes via email or phone with the Bohemian Net server owner.

Comments to Seller

When assembling an <u>Order</u> you can send comments to the Seller (owner of the Bohemian Net server).

Click on the Comments tab on the order form.

Comments to Seller

Enter any comments you want in the Comments to Seller section. They will be transmitted to the Seller when you request a quote or purchase the order.

Comments from Seller

When you receive an <u>order confirmation</u>, or a response to a quote, any comments from the Seller about any item you have ordered will be displayed for your review. Before you <u>accept or Cancel an order</u>, check these comments. There may be delivery or other important information there for you.

Order Confirmation

After assembling and sending an <u>Order</u>, a confirmation of receipt will be displayed. This means that the order has been received, and inventory has been allocated to you. Subject to appropriate sales tax, shipping charges and <u>Credit Authorization</u>, the ordered items will be <u>shipped</u> to you if you accept the confirmation.

Comments from Seller

When you receive an order confirmation, any comments from the Seller about any item you have ordered will be displayed for your review. Before you accept or cancel an order, check the comments from the Seller. There may be delivery or other important information there for you.

You can accept or cancel the order at this time.

IMPORTANT - Be sure to accept or cancel the order in a reasonable amount of time. Inventory is being held for you until you make this decision. If you do not respond within a specified time limit set by the operator of the Bohemian Net server, your order will be automatically canceled and you will be logged off. If this happens, simply purchase the order again.

After you accept an order, it will be recorded in the History tab automatically.

Accepting or Canceling Orders

Once you accept the order, you will need to take up any changes via email or phone with the Bohemian Net server owner. After you accept an order, it will be <u>Recorded in the History tab</u> automatically.

IMPORTANT - Be sure to accept or cancel the order in a reasonable amount of time. Inventory is being held for you until you make this decision. If you do not respond within a specified time limit set by the operator of the Bohemian Net server, your order will be automatically canceled and you will be logged off. If this happens, simply purchase the order again.

Once you cancel an order, the inventory will be made available to another caller by the Bohemian Net server and you will be returned to the open <u>Order Form</u> .

Keeping a History of Your Orders

When you save an <u>open order</u>, request a quote, or accept a <u>confirmed order</u>, a copy of the order will be placed in a history file on your local disk drive.

Click on the History tab on the <u>order form</u> to view a list of your open orders, quotes, confirmed orders and backorders.

Tracing an Order:

<u>Trace</u> the status of confirmed orders by highlighting a confirmed order and then clicking on the Trace button that appears. If a backorder is created, you can trace it also.

Getting the status of a Quote:

Trace the status of a request for quote by highlighting the quote and then clicking on the Status button that appears.

Order Name

The name you give to the order when saving it.

Order Status

Open - Order that has been composed and saved, but not quoted or purchased Quote - Order that you have requested a quote for and has been received by the Server Responded - Order you have requested a quote for and a response has been received back Confirmed - Order you have purchased and has been received by the Server Shipped - Portion of order that has been shipped Backorder - Portion of order that is still backordered and not yet shipped

Ordered Date

The date the order was originated.

Confirm Number

This number confirms that the seller has received a quote request or purchase request. If an order requires more than one shipment, it will show the same confirmation number for each partial shipment except that the 2-digit suffix will increment by 1 for each shipment.

Confirm Date

The date the order was confirmed as received by the Seller.

Open button

To view an order from the History grid, double-click on the order or highlight the order and click on the Open button.

Delete button

To delete an order from the History grid, highlight the order and click on the Delete button.

Copy button

To make a duplicate copy of a previous order, highlight the order and click on the Copy button. A copy will be made that you can quote or purchase.

Delivery of Your Order

Delivery or download of your <u>order</u> takes place subject to sales tax, shipping charges and <u>credit authorization</u> as follows:

- 1. Some soft goods, like program, text and image files can be transmitted to you while you are still connected to the Bohemian Net server. When you <u>trace</u> your shipment, a <u>download list</u> will appear, and you can either choose to download the file immediately or at a later time. If you choose to download later, you can access the list of available files by clicking on the View menu, then clicking on Download List.
- 2. Other soft goods, like services will require further action in person.
- 3. Hard goods, like products will be delivered to you according to the <u>Shipping Method and Address</u> you specified on the order.

Download List

In some cases the product you are purchasing will be a computer file. If this is the case, you need to wait until the Bohemian Net server <u>delivers</u> your order. The exception to this is if the cost of the file is zero.

If your <u>credit is authorized</u> using purchase credits, or if the server is equipped with automated credit card authorization, you will be able to download these files right away. Otherwise the operator of the Bohemian Net server will need to manually authorize your credit.

When you <u>trace</u> your shipment, a download list will appear, and you can either choose to download the file immediately or at a later time. If you choose to download later, you can access the list of available download files by clicking on the View menu, then clicking on Download List.

To download a file on the download list, highlight the file and click on the Download button.

The file will be downloaded into the directory in which you installed the Bohemian Net browser (this defaults to C:\BNBROWSE unless you changed it during installation), and further into the sub-directory named after the phone number of the Bohemian Net server you are downloading from. This may seem complicated at first, but it prevents overwriting files when products by the same name are ordered from different Bohemian Net servers.

Tracing Your Order

Purchases:

Once you have purchased a product using the <u>Order Form</u> and have received an <u>order confirmation</u>, you can trace the order to determine if your credit has been accepted and the order has been shipped.

If you are concerned about the status of shipment on an order or want to gain access to the download list, then Trace the order.

Load the Order Form, click on the <u>History</u> tab, highlight the order in the list that appears, and click on the Trace button that appears.

If your order has not yet been processed by the Seller, a message will appear telling you so.

If your order has been shipped, a copy of the order will be displayed with the status SHIPPED and will contain the following information:

The quantities shipped will be shown
Any backordered items will be shown
The Carrier Waybill and ship date will appear in the Ship tab (Trace with carrier)
Any additional comments from the Seller will appear in the Comment tab

If there have been any <u>backorders</u> created, an additional copy of the order will appear in the history grid with the status BACKORDERED. The confirmation number for this new order will be the same as the original confirmed order, except the 2-digit sequence number at the end of the confirmation number will be incremented by one. This indicates an additional shipment will need to take place to fill the order.

You can then trace the backorder as above. This process will repeat until the order is shipped complete.

Quotes:

If you want to check for the response on a guote request, then check the status of the quote.

Load the Order Form, click on the $\underline{\text{History}}$ tab, highlight the quote in the list that appears, and click on the Status button that appears.

If your request for quotation has not yet been responded to by the Seller, a message will appear telling you so.

If your request for quotation has been responded to by the Seller, a copy of the order will be displayed with any changes or additions created by the Seller.

Be sure to check for any Sellers comments in the Comment tab

If you like the response to your request, you can click on the Purchase button to turn the quote into an order, and the purchase request will be transmitted to the Buyer.

Backorder Processing

You will receive <u>Backorder Notification</u> when you order a larger quantity of a product than is currently available on the Bohemian Net server you are connected to.

If you decide to go ahead and <u>accept</u> the <u>confirmed order</u> with outstanding backorders, the Bohemian Net server keeps a record of your backorders.

You can determine the status of the confirmed order and any backorders by $\underline{\text{tracing}}$ the order.

Tracing an unshipped order:

If you trace an order that has not been shipped yet by the Seller, a message will appear telling you so. The daily message that appears when you log on to a Bohemian Net server will show you if you have any guote or purchase responses.

Tracing a shipped order:

If you trace a confirmed order that has been shipped, the status of the order will be changed to Shipped and a list of the items shipped will appear. The Waybill and ship date will appear in the Shipping tab and additional Seller comments may appear in the Comment tab

If there is a backorder on the shipment (i.e. if only a partial shipment has been made), a new instance of the order will appear in the grid, with the same confirmation number, with an 02 suffix. This order will have the status Backordered. When you view this order, it will display the items yet to be shipped.

Tracing a backorder:

If you trace a backorder, you will be given the status of that order as well (as above). If another partial shipment is made, another instance of the order will appear in the History grid, with the same confirmation number, with an 03 suffix (as above).

This process will continue until the order is shipped complete.

Return Merchandise Authorizations (RMA)

If you need to return merchandise to the Bohemian Net server your purchased it from, you will need to obtain an RMA number. This number is used by the operator of the server to process returns and to make sure that no returns are accepted without proper authorization in advance.

The RMA number needs to be written clearly on the outside of the box being returned.

If the Bohemian Net server has given you <u>Purchase Credits</u> as a payment option, you may be able to get credit for the RMA.

To obtain an RMA number and make appropriate arrangements, contact the owner of the Bohemian Net server you purchase the item from by phone or by <u>email</u>.

Sending an Email Message to the Seller

- 1. Click on the menu View, and then click on Email. You can also click on the Email icon on the speedbar.
- 2. Click on the New button and a blank Email form will appear.
- 3. Enter the Title for the Email.
- 4. Enter the message.
- 5. Create an Email Attachment if desired.
- 6. Click on the Send button to send the Email message. If you are not already logged onto the Bohemian Net server, a call will be initiated.

Checking Your Email

When you first log onto a Bohemian Net server, a daily message will appear. This message will let you know the number of email messages waiting for you. Otherwise, proceed as follows:

- 1. If necessary, select the Bohemian Net server you want to check for Email using the Bohemian Net Phone Book.
- 2. Click on the menu View, and then click on Email. You can also click on the Email icon on the speedbar.
- 3. Click on the Check mail button and a list of email will appear. If you are not already logged onto the Bohemian Net server, a call will be initiated.
- 4. A list of the Email addressed to you will appear. One column of the list indicates if there are any <u>attachments</u> included.
- 5. Click on the Read button to display the highlighted Email item.

Receiving an Email Message from the Seller

When you first log onto a Bohemian Net server, a daily message will appear. This message will let you know the number of email messages waiting for you.

To read an email message from the seller, click on the View menu, then click on Email. An inbox will appear listing all the mail from the Bohemian Net server currently displayed.

MSG#:

Displays the message number for each email message

Subject:

Displays the subject of each email message

Date/Time:

Displays the date and time that each email message was sent by the Seller

Status:

Displays the status of each email message as New, or as Read if it has been read.

Attach:

Indicates if there is an attachment to an email message.

Close button

Closes the email inbox

New button

Opens a new, blank email message

Read button

Displays the email message you have highlighted. You can then read and print the message, download any <u>attachments</u> and reply to the Seller with further attachments if desired.

Delete button

Deletes the email message you have highlighted.

Print button

Prints the email inbox list

Check Mail

Lets you check for email

Email Attachments

An Email attachment can be any computer file including program, document, and image files. Click on the Attachment button in a new Email message to browse for and select an attachment file to include in your email.

If you have received an email from the Seller with an attachment, you will find the attachment in the directory where you installed your copy of the Bohemian Net browser (this defaults to C:\BNBROWSE unless you changed it during installation). It will be in the subdirectory named after the phone number of the server in a further subdirectory named EMAIL. This may seem complicated at first, but it keeps files by the same name from being overwritten when getting mail from a variety of servers.

Licensing Information

For licensing Information, click on the Help menu, and then click on License Information A copy of the license contract will be displayed along with the name of the registered owner.

Please review this information carefully. It defines the conditions under which Bohemian Net products can be used. It also contains important non-disclaimers and limitations on our liability for malfunction of the Bohemian Net software suite.

Note: It is against the law to use this program to export anything to a restricted country. If you have any doubt about which countries are restricted, consult your nearest Customs House or a Freight forwarder in your area. The penalties are severe, so Buyer and Seller beware.

Configuring your modem

Every effort has been made to make Bohemian Net software products compatible with the standard modems currently on the market. However, we cannot guarantee that all modems, hardware configurations and phone lines will be supported. Also every effort has been made to accommodate noisy and temperamental residential telephone line connections.

Telephone lines - Once your modem is set up properly, you should not experience any difficulty except for an occasional super-noisy line. Bohemian Net software uses quality ZMODEM error-checking protocol on <u>all transfers</u> of commands and data between the browser and the server. This means that if an error occurs in the transfer, the data will be sent again. In the event of a very noisy line, a timeout may occur after a number of repeat transfers. You will be given a warning message. Often time you can just try dialing in again and you will get a cleaner line.

NOTE: We suggest that you follow the directions in your modem manual about contacting the phone company to clean your line for data transfer.

Modem setup - A large number of industry initialization strings have been included with the program. A list appears during installation of the product.

If you are having trouble with the modem you selected during installation, or if you have made changes to your modem or the communications port it is hooked up to, click on the Options menu and chose <u>Modem setup</u> from the submenu that appears. Change the information to conform to your current configuration, then save the new information and reexecute the program.

If you still have a problem, see if your modem is working with other programs. There are many variables connected with modem transfers. They include the computer configuration, the communications port used, the way the port is setup in Windows, interrupt settings, network conflict, memory address settings, the modem switch settings, serial cables, phone jacks/lines, and even the quality of the phone line. Check all these.

You may have to consult your modem manual or consult the person who installed the modem if it continues to not work.

Referrals

Built into the Bohemian Net browser are two referral systems.

1. When <u>installing the Bohemian Net browser</u>, the referred by field will normally contain the name of the person who recommended this product to you. If no name is in the field, you should enter the name of that person. We track referrals, and reward people who recommend our products. To display the referral name, click on the Options menu, then click on <u>Account Setup</u>.

If you want to pass on a copy of the Bohemian Net browser to a friend, you can include your name as a referral. When the browser is installed, simply ask the user to include your name in the Referred by field in the registration screen that appears. Any activity by that browser will then have a relational link to your name.

2. When you access another Bohemian Net server using the <u>Bohemian Net Phone Book</u>, both the server you are exiting and the server you are calling will record the fact that one server is referring another. This information is available to the owner of the Bohemian Net servers so they can acknowledge referrals from another server.

Bohemian Net Phone Book

The Bohemian Net Phone Book is a place to store the names and phone numbers of other Bohemian Net servers. Use the phone book to move from one Bohemian Net server to another.

Access the phone book by clicking on the View menu, then click on Phone Book. You can double-click on a name in the list to select it, or highlight one and click on the Select button.

Phone book entries:

A list of available Bohemian Net servers. You can add to this list at any time. You can also retrieve server lists from each server you call, and then add the ones you want to keep to your personal list (see Server List below).

Server Name:

The name of the server highlighted in the server list.

Telephone number:

The phone number of the server highlighted in the server list.

Server Description:

A description of the server highlighted in the server list.

Referred by:

The person who referred the server, highlighted in the server list, to you.

Last Called:

Displays the last date and time you called the server highlighted in the server list

Times Called:

Displays the times you have called the server highlighted in the server list.

OK button

Closes the phone book and keeps all changes

New button

Creates a new phone book entry. Just fill out the form.

Edit button

Edits information for the server highlighted in the server list.

Cancel button

Cancels all current edits.

Remove button

Removes the server highlighted in the server list

Server List button

Displays the server list of the Bohemian Net server you are connected to. To populate this list, you need to click on the Options menu, then click on Retrieve Server List. You need to be connected to a server to do this, otherwise the command will be disabled. Once you retrieve the list, you can add and remove servers to your own personal list using the Select, Remove and Select all buttons.

Select button

Makes the server highlighted in the server list the active Bohemian Net server you will dial

up. You can also double-click on a name in the list to select it.

Find button

Enables you to search for the name of a server as your list grows in size.

Storefront image (Home Page)

The Storefront image is the graphic that appears when you dialup a Bohemian Net server (store) using a Bohemian Net browser. It provides access to the goods and/or services available on that server.

To see what is available, move your cursor over the surface of the graphic. Yellow stickies will appear showing the <u>Hotspot Categories</u> of information available to you.

Modem Setup Screen

The modem setup screen stores the modem configuration information that you entered during registration of the Bohemian Net browser. Edit the information shown if you change modems or want to reconfigure modem parameters

Modem type:

Select your modem from the list of modems by clicking on the down arrow on the combo box.

Initialization string:

When you select a modem from the Modem type list, an initialization string for that modem will appear. This is the recommended string to use. You should edit this string only when you are experiencing communications problems and/or are obtaining customer support.

Speaker volume:

Set the speaker volume of your modem.

Call waiting:

Enable or disable call waiting. Call waiting will often interfere with communications via modem. The default setting is disable

Comm port:

Select the COM port your modem is attached to. The default setting is COM 2. If you have any doubt about this, consult your computer manual or ask your computer dealer. Typical computers will have two COM ports, so you can always just try both COM1 and COM2 and the chance is that one will work.

Baud rate:

Select the baud rate of your modem. It is recommended you use 19200 even though you have a 14400 baud modem. You will also need to set up your COM port within Windows so it will operate at that rate. Refer to the Windows procedure manual for instructions if necessary.

Line type:

Select Tone or Pulse depending on your telephone service. The default setting is Tone.

Test button

Runs a test on the modem and displays the results in a text screen. This is for diagnostics, but it will also give you an indication that your modem is working.

Account Setup Screen

The account setup screen stores the account information that you entered during registration of the Bohemian Net browser. It is important that this information is correct.

This information will be used as default when you create orders using the Bohemian Net browser. It will be used as Billing address and Shipping address information unless you specifically change those items on the order form. It will then be used by the Bohemian Net server to process your orders. Be sure that this information is entered correctly. It will also be used to provide program <u>revisions</u>.

Ordered by:

By default, this field is blank and the contents of the Name will appear in the By: field of the <u>order form</u>. It shows who is originating the order. However, if there is a name in this field, it will then appear on the order form as default.

Default Shipping:

This default <u>shipping method</u> will appear on the order form as default. You can change it when composing the order.

Default Billing:

This default <u>payment method</u> will appear on the order form as default. You can change it when composing the order.

Referred By:

This field will contain the name of the person or company responsible for your using this copy of the Bohemian Net browser.
