

Sunlight suits cactus and other succulents best; they can usually adapt to any window except north. Plant in a clay pot with equal parts coarse sand, potting soil, and leaf mold. Succulents should dry out between waterings. Graft cactus by cutting off the top of one plant to form a base or rootstock; cut off the bottom of another and center it on the base. Tie a string around the top of the grafted part and the pot until the two parts join.
