Persian Violet

Also called German violet (*Exacum affine*)

Persian violet produces pale blue, fragrant flowers in fall and winter. Start a new plant each year.

Light

Expose to medium (bright indirect) light. Plant does not bloom well in low light.

Water

Allow soil surface to dry between thorough waterings. Mist daily. Raise humidity.

Temperature

Maintain temperatures of 60 to 70 degrees.

Comments

Feed every 14 days with mild solution during active growth. Remove spent blossoms. Propagate by seed, maintaining a soil temperature of 68 degrees or higher.
