Crape Myrtle

(Lagerstroemia indica)

One-and-a-half- to 2-inch flowers on clusters 8 to 12 inches long in late summer. White,pink, red, lavender blooms. Leaves turn yellow and red in the fall. Bark peels in an attractive whorled pattern.

Zone: 7

Light and Soil: Full sun. Moist, rich, well-drained soil.

Height: 7-20'

Comments

Pest- and disease-resistant. Prune in early spring before flowering. Use in informal hedges or as specimen plants.
