

Raphiolepis

Also called indian hawthorn

(Raphiolepis indica)

Three-and-a-half-inch-long, dark green leaves. Pinkish half-inch flowers in loose clusters in April, followed by clusters of blue-black berries. Rosea cultivar has deep pink blooms.

Zone: 9

Light and Soil: Tolerant of most soil and light conditions.

Height: 5'

Slow growing, so pick them flat or upright according to your landscape needs.
