

Crab Apple

(Malus sp.)

Type: Deciduous

Zone: Varies

Height and Width: 10'-50' tall, 20' wide; Average 15' tall, 15' wide

Shade Density: Light to medium

Fall Foliage: Yellow;orange;brown

Soil Preference: Rich, well-drained

Comments

Grows in almost any climate in U. S. Produces single, double, or semi-double, 1- to 2-inch white or pink flowers in spring followed by 1/2-inch yellow, green, or red fruits; good in jellies and for birds. Use as specimen tree or in row along drive.
