What is Icon Eyes?

Icon Eyes are various animated characters that watch the mouse cursor as it moves across the screen. Some blink, and some of the characters get bored if there's no movement and will fall asleep. Icon Eyes has seven different characters to choose from.

Shareware Concept

Most money back guarantees work like this: You pay for the product and then have some period of time to try it and see whether or not you like it. If you don't like it or find that it doesn't do what you need, you return it (undamaged) and at some point - which might take months - you get your money back. Some software companies won't even let you try their product! In order to qualify for a refund, the diskette envelope must have an unbroken seal. With these "licensing" agreements, you only qualify for your money back if you haven't tried the product. How absurd!

Shareware is very different. With shareware you get to use it for a limited time, without spending a penny. You are able to use the software on your own system(s), in your own special work environment, with no sales people looking over your shoulder. If you decide to continue using it, then - and only then - do you pay for it.

Shareware is a distribution method, NOT a type of software. Shareware is produced by accomplished programmers, just like retail software. There is good and bad shareware, just as there is good and bad retail software. The primary difference between shareware and retail software is that with shareware you know if it's good or bad BEFORE you pay for it.

As a software user, you benefit because you get to use the software to determine whether it meets your needs before you pay for it; and authors benefit because they are able to get their products into your hands without the hundreds of thousands of dollars in expenses it takes to launch a traditional retail software product. There are many programs on the market today which would never have become available without the shareware marketing method.

The shareware system and the continued availability of quality shareware products depends on your willingness to register and pay for the shareware you use. The registration fees you pay allow us to continue to develop our products.

Please show your support for shareware by registering those programs you actually use and by passing them on to others. Shareware is kept alive by YOUR support!
