

Dialing Numbers

When calling to a number with a different area code in the U.S. or Canada from a U.S. or Canadian number, dial the Dial Preamble, then the Area Code, then the seven-digit number. Making international calls is a bit different, however. For all long distance companies that offer long distance direct dialing, the International Access Code (011) is used as a dial preamble. Generally to make a direct international call you must dial, in this order, 011, the Country Code, the City Code, and then the number. After dialing, you should allow at least 45 seconds for the call to connect. For any other type of international calling, these instructions will differ, depending on your long-distance company.
