Located in Holiday Park, in Fort Lauderdale, Parker Playhouse is considered by both performers and audiences to be one of the finest playhouses in which to share the "theatre experience". Built by Louis Parker and donated to the city of Fort Lauderdale in 1966, Parker Playhouse has a long tradition of presenting the best in touring Broadway and pre-Broadway shows.

The beautiful grounds and neoclassical décor contribute to the audience's theatrical experience. The playhouse seats approximately 1200 people in a continental seating format that is comfortable while providing excellent sight lines. In conjunction with its fine acoustics, there is literally not a bad seat in the house.

In addition to Broadway, Parker Playhouse also hosts such events as Florida Singing Sons, Boys and Girls Club, YMCA, and the Fort Lauderdale Players. Previous clients include, Blockbuster Entertainment, The South Florida Emmy Awards, Museum of Science & Discovery Center, Miami City Ballet, Florida Philharmonic and Gilda's Club.
