Overview:

A Full-size Pickup for all Reasons

The full-size Chevrolet C/K pickup truck has historically been General Motors' best-selling vehicle line, outselling all the General's passenger-car nameplates and second only to Ford's F-Series full-size pickups in total sales by nameplate.

The current C/K pickups were originally introduced for the 1988 model year, and have been updated periodically since then, most recently with the addition of an improved 4.3-liter V6 power plant in 1993, and a 6.5-liter diesel V8 of 155-HP. Automatic transmissions are now electronically-controlled four-speed units.

Chevrolet has facelifted the C/K series for model year 1995. Interiors have been redesigned, with new door trim panels, softer seats, and, most importantly, a driver's side airbag. Also, four wheel antilock brakes replace the rear wheel type previously used.

The C/K pickup is available in a bewildering variety of four wheelbases as well as multiple cab and cargo bed configurations. A choice of rear wheel drive or four wheel drive is also offered, to enable the personal-use buyer as well as the work-truck customer the ability to individually customize his vehicle. Payloads range up to 10,000 pounds.

In 1994, the median age of Chevrolet C/K pickup truck buyers was about 40. Over 90 percent were male.
