Overview:

Full-size Pickup Adds Comfort

For model year 1995, GMC has revised the interiors of its full-size Sierra pickup trucks to provide added comfort. Seats and door panels are upgraded for a less truck-like look, and a driver's side airbag has now been added as standard equipment. Automatic transmission models now include a shift interlock feature. Instrument panels feature improved design controls and displays, as well.

Sierra drivetrains for model year 1995 include a standard 4.3-liter V6 of 165-HP, and a variety of optional power plants is available, including gasoline V8s of 5.0-liters, 5.7-liters, and 7.4-liters, with 175, 210, and 230-HP, respectively. Diesel engines are also available in both turbocharged and non-turbocharged form, with outputs ranging from 155 to 190-HP.

Add to this the selection of wheelbases, cab styles, bed lengths and configurations, as well as rear- or four-wheel drive, and it's obvious that no matter what one's truck-buying priorities may be, GMC probably offers a model with the size, power, and style to suit.

During 1994, GMC Sierra pickup trucks were bought primarily by males (over 90%) in their early-to-mid forties.
