Not Just an Asian Ranger

For model year 1994, Mazda's B-Series compact pickup trucks were completely redesigned, and used the chassis and inner body structure of the class-leading Ford Ranger pickup; in fact, the new Mazda trucks are built in a Ford assembly plant in New Jersey.

The move to Ford major componentry has meant an increase in the scope of Mazda's compact pickup model line. For example, power plant choices now range from a 2.3-liter four cylinder to V6 power plants of either 3.0 or 4.0 liters. Horsepower ratings range from 98 to 160, and all engines can be had with five-speed manual transmissions

or four-speed automatics. Like the Ranger, a choice of regular or "Cab Plus" extended versions are available, as is a choice of cargo bed lengths.

Mazda has provided modified exterior styling touches for its pickups, and the B-Series has retained some typical Mazda pickup styling touches, particularly in the front end design and side window trim, although front and rear fenders are also unique to the Mazda truck.

For model year 1995, a driver's side airbag has been added to Mazda's compact pickup truck line, and optional alloy wheels are newly redesigned. In 1994, the median age of Mazda pickup owners ranged from 37 (for 4WD models) to 41 (for 2WD versions). Over eighty percent of buyers were male.
