#### **Overview:**

#### Sophisticated Sport Utility

Mitsubishi's upscale Montero compact sport utility was most recently redesigned for the 1992 model year, offering a slightly smoother and more refined exterior without abandoning the rugged character the nameplate enjoyed. Montero's interior was significantly upgraded in the '92 revisions, offering a higher degree of luxury and comfort, befitting a premium-position SUV.

Mitsubishi added a standard driver's airbag to all Monteros for the 1994 model year, and made an upgraded, 3.5-liter, 24 valve V6 of 215-HP standard in topline "SR" versions, addressing customer requests for added off-the-line performance with the engine's 228 foot pounds of torque. For the '95 model year, Mitsubishi replaces the standard 3.0-liter, 155-HP V6 in "base" Monteros with a more powerful, 177-HP version of the engine. Instrument panels have been slightly revised; on the theory that few Monteros engage in serious off-road work, the unique inclinometer has been deleted from the instrument cluster.

All Monteros feature four wheel power disc brakes, a full complement of power-operated convenience items, and a seven-passenger capacity thanks to three-row seating. Topline "SR" models add standard air conditioning, ABS, upgraded audio and interior trim, heated mirrors, and an independently-suspended driver's seat, among other items. Thanks to the generous standard equipment level, the option list is limited, but it does include items such as a power sunroof, audio system CD changer, and a leather upholstery/wood interior trim package.

Mitsubishi plans a moderate facelift for the 1996 Montero, which should appear during the fourth quarter of 1995. Among the changes will be driver and passenger airbags in a further revised interior.

Buyers of 1994 Mitsubishi Monteros had a median age of just under 39 years of age; about ten percent were age 55 or older. Two thirds of principal drivers were men.
