Mitsubishi's current entry in the compact pickup truck wars, the Mighty Max, has been offered in its current form since a 1988 model year redesign which resulted in a truck of slightly larger exterior and interior dimensions than its predecessor, as well as much more angular and rugged styling. Since then, a minor facelift in 1993 added exterior chrome accents and a freshened interior, with revised instrument panel design and new interior trim.

While its compact pickup product line isn't as extensive as some home-grown competitors, Mitsubishi offers a rugged 2.4-liter, 116-HP four cylinder as Mighty Max's standard power plant, available with either a five-speed manual transmission or a four-speed automatic gearbox. Airbags are not available.

The 1995 model year will be one of minimal change for the Mitsubishi Mighty Max pickup, aside from revised exterior colors.

In 1994, the typical Mitsubishi Mighty Max buyer had a median age of 40; buyers of 4WD models were slightly older. Nearly 85 percent were male.
