Fuel Efficiency Redesigned

For model year 1995, Suzuki has fully redesigned its Swift mini-compact offerings. The new Swift three-door hatchback is larger inside and out compared to its immediate predecessor, with improved ride comfort. Standard safety features now include driver and passenger airbags, and a GM-developed anti-lock brake system is optionally available for the first time (The Swift is also sold in substantially similar form as the Geo Metro).

Styling of the new Swift is more aerodynamic and rounded than the previous car, with flared rear fenders adding a distinctive touch. Power continues to be provided by a 1.3-liter three cylinder engine of 70-HP; as a result the Swift is expected to retain its position near the top of the EPA's fuel economy ratings.

Suzuki has dropped the previously-available four-door sedan version of the Swift, as it will add an all-new and slightly larger four-door sedan during the 1995 model year. The previous "GT" version of the Swift had also been deleted for the new model year.

Buyers of Suzuki Swifts had a median age of about 35 during 1994, and twenty percent were 25 years of age or younger. About 55 percent were female.
