Monitor Window:

Read-Only Volumes

Do not "monitor" directories on read only-volumes. You can open a window and "view" images in a directory on a read-only volume, but you will need to turn off the monitoring. Instead of monitoring the directory, use the Refresh command to update the monitor window if necessary.

Renaming Files

If you want to rename the files in the directory you are monitoring, you should do it from within ImageAXS using the RENAME command. If you rename a file outside of ImageAXS (i.e., from the File Manager) while a monitor window is open, the file disappears from the monitor window. The only way to make the file reappear in the monitor window is to use the REFRESH command.

Deleting Files

If you want to delete files from the directory you are monitoring, you should do it from within ImageAXS using the DELETE SOURCE FILES command. If you delete files outside of ImageAXS (i.e. from the File Manager) while ImageAXS is running and a monitor window is open, the files in the monitor window will not all disappear at one time. Instead they will disappear a few at a time as ImageAXS monitors for those images currently visible in the monitor window and is unable to locate them.
