To use this reference:

Abbreviations used in this reference:

Sh Shift Bksp ... Backspace
^ Control Spcbr... Spacebar
Alt Alt db dialog box

To print the information on a screen:

Select Print Topic from the File menu of this Help file.

To return to the main PhotoStyler Help file:

Click the Contents button on the ribbon along the top of this screen.

Files/Workspace: Manage image files and your workspace.

Tools: Access and use tools quickly.

Viewing: Add views and control zoom.

Selections/Masks: Create and edit selections and masks.

Editing and Transforming: Cut, copy, paste, rotate, distort, etc.

Paint/Enhance: Tools and commands for painting and enhancing.

To back up while using the free selection tool:

While still holding the left mouse button, press Bksp.

To unpaint part of a stroke (paint or image group tool):

Drag the cursor while holding the right mouse button.

If a dialog box obstructs the view of the image:

- Collapse/expand db F2
- Move db to upper left of screen F5
- Move db to lower left of screen F6
- Move db to upper right of screen F7
- Move db to lower right of screen F8

- Select invert ^I
- Expand selection ^E
- Soft edge ^T
- Remove holes from selection Sh^H
- Make floating selection Sh^K
- Stamp floating selection Sh^T

- Export mask Sh^E
- Import mask Sh^I
- Mask options Sh^O
- Image layer Sh^L
- Mask layer Sh^M
- Preserve image ^B
- Merge control ^M
- Hide/show marquee ^H

Discard floating selection Del

To alter the selection (while a selection tool is active):

Add to selection Sh & make selection

Remove from selection ... ^ & make selection

Intersection Sh^ & make selection

Deselect selection right mouse button

To back up while using the free selection tool:

While still holding the left mouse button, press Bksp.
